SWIMMING POOL RULES

Pool Conditions of Use – Group 3 Activities

(Camp Groups, School Groups & Unstructured Recreational Use)

These conditions apply to all Group 3 users of the Swan Valley Adventure Centre (SVAC) Swimming Pool.

1. Compliance Requirements

- All user groups must comply with the [WA Health Code of Practice for the Design, Construction, Operation, Management and Maintenance of Aquatic Facilities](#) (current edition).
- A copy of the Code of Practice is available from SVAC Reception.
- All discrete user groups must provide **appropriately qualified and responsible adult supervisors** for their group's pool use.
- **School groups** must comply with all **Department of Education aquatic activity guidelines**, including minimum qualification and supervision requirements.
- All visiting groups must hold **current Public Liability Insurance**.

2. Booking & Access

- **All swimming pool use must be pre-booked** with SVAC. Bookings are subject to availability.
- SVAC does **not** provide pool supervision or lifeguard services for Group 3 activities.
- **Pool gate -**
The supervisor must ensure:
 - The gate is **opened** only during the confirmed booking time.
 - The gate is **locked** immediately when the group leaves the pool area.
 - All personal items are removed from the pool compound when departing.

3. Supervisor Responsibilities

The visiting organisation is **fully responsible** for pool supervision and safety management during their booked session.

Supervisors must:

- Hold a **relevant and valid aquatic rescue and first aid qualification** suitable for Group 3 pool use.
- Actively supervise all swimmers at all times.
- Ensure pool entry is restricted to their booked group only.
- Enforce all **SVAC Pool Rules**, which are displayed on the sign at the pool area.

4. Safety Equipment & Emergency Preparedness

- A **life buoy** is available and a **megaphone** is located within the storage box in the swimming pool compound, for emergency use.
- Supervisors must have a **mobile phone** available during the entire pool session.

5. Maximum Numbers

To maintain safe supervision:

- A maximum of **25 swimmers per qualified supervisor** applies (activity dependent).
- **No more than 100 swimmers** may enter the water at any time.

Supervisors must ensure ratios are maintained throughout the session, including during transitions and breaks.

6. Pool Rules

- All swimmers must follow the **Swan Valley Adventure Centre Pool Rules** displayed inside the pool area.
- Supervisors are responsible for ensuring all participants understand and adhere to these rules before entering the water.

7. Departure Requirements

Before leaving the pool area:

- Ensure all participants have exited the water and the compound.
- Remove all personal belongings.
- Return the pool cleaner to the pool, if requested and inducted by SVAC Staff.
- Lock the gate securely.
- Report any hazards, damage, or incidents to SVAC staff immediately.
